## **Laboratory Mentoring Expectations Agreement:**

## My minimum expectations for you.

<u>Fulfill</u> your commitments regarding average time in the lab. Be on time for appointments and communicate in advance in writing if you must reschedule. Plan to be in lab when other people are in the lab on a regular basis.

<u>Participate</u> intellectually in the scientific endeavor. Read the literature I send you, and find papers on your own when appropriate.

<u>Ask</u> questions. The lab is a safe space to ask questions, learn, and grow. If you have forgotten something about a protocol, ask. When you do not understand why a step is performed, ask. To help you gain independence, write down the answers to questions so you can complete tasks when the lab is empty. When you attend a research presentation, ask questions there too. Your perspective can generate new ideas and help the presenter know where to clarify their future presentations.

<u>Maintain</u> your lab notebook up-to-date and properly label all your samples with date, initials, and contents. It prevents waste and loss in the future.

Write a report after every semester in the lab that includes a research summary and future directions.

<u>Clean</u> up after yourself. It is essential for the lab to run smoothly and for equipment to last. Leave equipment and benchtops in the same, or better, state as you found them.

Be respectful towards all other lab members in word and action.

<u>Train</u> you in lab protocols and provide a <u>context</u> for your research through literature and data.

Provide you with a safe and well-regulated work <u>environment</u> to the best of my ability, and train you in general lab safety, specific safety features of our lab, and in ethical issues pertaining to our work.

<u>Listen</u> to your concerns and ideas with respect, even if I have a different perspective.

Help you find resources for career <u>development</u> to the best of my abilities.

Facilitate <u>interactions</u> with other scientists in the lab and our f	field, including opportunities to present your data.
